This is achieved by maintaining an Integrated Management System (IMS) covering the activities of our operation and meeting the requirements of AS/NZS 4801:2001.

Our objective of eliminating work-related injury and illness is achieved by:

- Conforming to legislative and industry requirements;
- Managing risks associated with our business activities;
- Providing a work environment without risks to health and safety;
- Providing and maintaining safe plant and structures;
- Providing and maintaining safe systems of work;
- Ensuring the safe use handling and storage of plant and chemicals;
- Providing adequate facilities for the welfare at work of workers in carrying out work for Arnold, including ensuring access to those facilities;
- Providing competent supervision, training, instruction and information;
- Monitoring the health of workers and the conditions at the workplace for the purpose of preventing illness or injury of workers; and
- Establishing measurable objectives and targets to chart our progress.
