We are committed to the elimination of hazards and reduction of health and safety risks to as low as reasonably practicable. We will maintain a management system that covers the activities of our operation and meeting the requirements of AS/NZS 4801:2001 and its continual improvement towards meeting the requirements of ISO 45001:2018.

Our objective is to maintain a culture and management system which ensures the health and safety of all personnel through the provision of visible safety leadership, resources, processes, education and a demonstrated commitment to this policy.

This objective is achieved by:

- identifying and controlling hazards and associated risks associated with our business activities to as low as reasonably practicable
- empowering employees and subcontractors to stop work where they deem it to be unsafe until the identified hazard can be controlled to as low as reasonably practicable
- identifying and conforming to legislative and other requirements
- providing and maintaining safe plant and equipment
- providing and continually improving safe systems of work
- consulting with and enabling participation of employees in relation to health and safety
- ensuring the safe use handling and storage of plant and chemicals
- providing competent supervision, training, instruction and information
- monitoring the health of workers and the conditions at the workplace for the purpose of preventing illness or injury of workers, and
- establishing measurable objectives and targets to chart our progress.
